22 Harvest Street Update

Today, a Monroe County Grand Jury Indictment was unsealed, charging **Jesus Castro-Ubiles, 27 of Rochester** (pictured below) with the following: Kidnapping in the 1st Degree (4 counts), Assault in the 1st Degree (2 counts), Gang Assault in the 1st Degree (2 counts), Robbery in the 1st Degree (6 counts), Robbery in the 2nd Degree (2 counts), Predatory Sexual Assault in the 1st Degree (9 counts), Criminal Use of a Firearm in the 1st Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree (2 counts). All crimes are related to the December 5, 2015 kidnapping of two University of Rochester students. As a result of the effortless actions of the Rochester Police Department and the Monroe County District Attorney's Office, (8) people were arrested and charged in connection with the kidnapping.

"I am truly grateful for the persistent efforts of the US Marshals Fugitive Task Force in assisting us in this case." said Rochester Police Chief Michael Ciminelli. "We truly appreciate all of their hard work leading to the apprehension of this suspect."
