



Community Update: Attempted Robbery/Grand Larceny Arrest

The Rochester Police Department - Goodman Section – would like to make the community aware of a recent attempted robbery/grand larceny arrest that occurred on Grand Avenue.

On 6/14/18, at around 11:28 P.M., the Rochester Police Department responded to the 700 block of Grand Avenue for the report of a robbery. The investigation revealed that four suspects attempted to forcible take property from the victim while armed with what appeared to be a pistol.

The victim did defend himself by drawing his legally permitted handgun and shooting one of the suspects. After further investigation officers arrested the four suspects. One of the offenders is a juvenile, and cannot be identified.

Ronald Cook was charged with attempted robbery 1st, and attempted grand larceny 4th.

Summeran Patterson was charged with attempted robbery 1st, and attempted grand larceny 4th.

Jaeylon Johnson was charged with attempted robbery 1st, and attempted grand larceny 4th.
